Through the medium of the arts, EUNIC Ethiopia's "**Stations of Culture - Stations of Dialogue**" project nurtures dialogue with the purpose of building social cohesion and peace within times featuring reduced spaces for civic society and creative expression. By curating engaging cultural experiences on sites along the first Addis Abeba - Djibouti train line and related sites across Ethiopia (and possibly Djibouti), the project creates innovative platforms for cultural exchange, artistic expression and open dialogue for a period of six weeks between March and May 2025.

The project thus aims to spark lasting dialogue at three levels: between EUNIC Ethiopia members and their Local partners, between the participating European and Ethiopian artists, and amongst the audiences participating in the cultural experiences.

We call on Project Managers or Cultural Producers with strong project management skills to submit **work samples**, their **CV** and a **letter of motivation (max. 1000 words)**. It should explain why they are the best person to manage selected cultural activities and creative expressions that demonstrate the overall value of art, as well as its ability to address societal issues and foster open dialogue. a Project Manager or Cultural Producer that is able to:

- Speak and write excellent English and Amharic
- Refine and produce digital, in-person, and hybrid cultural activities as part of "Stations of Culture - Stations of Dialogue" in close cooperation with EUNIC Ethiopia, their partners, and the participating artists
- Follow up with the networks of participating artists and creative professionals to ensure the delivery, documentation, and promotion of cultural activities
- Support EUNIC Ethiopia with the project budget
- Prepare two final reports (internal & external) that comprehensively summarize the project procedures and its outcomes, including quantitative figures for all digital, in-person, and hybrid activities

Bring together different artists and creatives from the creative sector in order to highlight the values of free artistic expression and open dialogue

Be advised, the applicants motivation statements and work samples will need to effectively demonstrate the applicant's leadership, problem solving, communication, delegation and team building skills along with providing at least three references that can vouch for their overall integrity and competence.

The remuneration for the work shall be announced to shortlisted applicants.

Station of Culture - Stations of Dialogue is a project by EUNIC Ethiopia and their partners. EUNIC – European Union National Institutes for Culture – is Europe's network of national cultural institutes and organisations, with 36 members from all 28 EU member states.

Be advised, applicants need to be based in Addis Abeba and be able to work for 20hrs per week (min) from 02. December 2024 till 30 May 2025.
